What information is being collected by Spirit Finance Team?

When you contact us by phone and email we may need to collect personal information about your business so that the appropriate service can be provided. The information we require from you may include personal information, such as:

- First name
- Family name or surname
- Business address
- Telephone numbers
- Email address
- Payment details

How is it collected?

• Directly from the company/employee/contractor

Why is it being collected?

This information is being collected in order for legitimate interest of the Data Controller. This would be processing invoices and payments.

Information is collected for

This would be for processing invoices and payments and day to day business management.

How will it be used?

- To process payments
- To chase payment

Who will it be shared with?

Only within the finance team and other Spirit employees

Where will the data be stored?

All data collect will be stored within the United Kingdom.

Automated decisions

No automated decision making is used with the data collected.



Your rights as a data subject

As a data subject, you have a number of rights. You can:

- Access and obtain a copy of your data on request;
- Require the organisation to change incorrect or incomplete data;
- Require the organisation to delete or stop processing your data, for example where the data is no longer necessary for the purposes of processing; and
- Object to the processing of your data where Spirit is relying on its legitimate interests as the legal ground for processing.
