5 Steps To Using Your SpiritCare Incontinence Sheath

1. Getting started

Note: Your healthcare professional is able to help you select the correct sheath size.

Always wash your hands before starting. Trim pubic hair from the base of the penis to avoid hair sticking to the adhesive and promote a good seal. Do not shave the area as this can cause irritation. Clean the penis head and surrounding area with soap and water. Do not use talcum powder or creams as this will prevent the sheath from sticking to the penis.



2. Applying the sheath

Allow the area to dry before applying the sheath. Remove the unrolled sheath from the packaging and discard the tray. To apply, position over the tip of the penis and slowly unroll along the full length. With your hand, press gently along the penis shaft to create a seal, ensuring no wrinkles for maximum adhesion. The warmth of your hand will help activate the adhesive.









3. Connection


Before connecting the sheath to your lea bag or drainage bag you must carry out some basic checks. Remove protective caps to expose the ridged connector and make sure the drainage outlet is in the closed position. When the bag is secure and in position, insert the connector of the bag into the sheath funnel. Push firmly to ensure a leak-proof connection. Check there are no kinks in the bag tubing to ensure continuous urine flow.





Providing the sheath is intact and the skin appears to be in good condition, the sheath can be worn for up to 24 hours. Use plenty of soap and water to remove the sheath perhaps when in the shower or bath.
